After our donations to the International & State Lions Club charities at the recent District Convention in Oconomowoc, we have \$4,418 left in the community service accounts. A donation to the Wisconsin Lions Camp has been made in memory of Lion Chuck Davis. At the March board meeting, it was decided to donate \$500 to the Veterans Honor Flight, which provides all-expenses paid trips for World War II veterans to Washington D.C. And includes a trip to the World War II Memorial. This donation has been made in memory of Lion Paul Kellner, who was a World War II veteran (Navy).



The receipts haven't been tallied yet for the (Pancake) Breakfast With The Lions event last weekend, but we served 456 meals, which include 154 to S.J.N.M.A. Cadets. We had some sausages and ham left over, and this food was donated to the Hartland Food Pantry.

We received a thank-you note from Audrey Kellner expressing the family's appreciation for the Lions Club's flowers and attendance at Lion Paul's memorial service.
